relative ease.

Looking after Solid Surface

Important: Please read the information carefully and ensure your keep these instructions for future reference.

Important: Please read and follow instructions carefully when using care & maintenance products. Always wear suitable protective gloves when using chemicals to prevent any cracking, drying or other reaction to your skin.

Every day cleaning

The products should be cleaned daily by applying a bathroom type cleaner. Remember, it is always easier to wipe up a spill than to have to deal with a dried-on stain.

- For daily cleaning, spray the surface with the "stone guard anti-bacterial surface cleaner" supplied. Then wipe down the surface with the "yellow micro fibre cloth" to remove any oils and grease.
- · If any stains need further attention please then follow the persistent stains instructions below.

Note: For WC cleaning, as with any WC pan, we would highly recommend that when the cleaning products are applied, that this application is aided and accompanied by the use of a proprietary WC pan scrubbing brush for internal pan cleaning.

Persistent stains

Persistent stains, such as: limescale build up and surface marks require more attention than a daily cleaning procedure.

- To remove more persistent stains from the solid surface item use the "lightly abrasive solid surface cream cleaner" supplied. Once applied rub the product down in a circular motion with the "yellow micro fibre cloth".
- If this method is ineffective a more abrasive clean may be needed. Start by applying the "cream cleaner" then rubbing the stain in a circular motion with the "white polishing abrasive disc". This will remove most stubborn marks and restore the surface colour.
- To restore the product to its original finish, you will also then need to polish the product using the "stone guard anti-bacterial surface cleaner" and the "yellow micro fibre cloth" which will return the product to its original lustre.

Restoration

Darker coloured surfaces are more prone to minor scuffs and scratches than lighter options and will require more care and attention to keep them looking pristine, however most scratches can be removed with relative ease.

- Deep surface marks or scratches can be rubbed down using the "180 grit foam backed sandpaper pad" supplied and applying the "lightly abrasive solid surface cream cleaner".
- Once the initial stage has been completed remove any abrasion marks to restore the surface's former lustre polish. Start by using progressively less abrasive pads, starting with the "maroon abrasive disc", then the "grey abrasive disc" and finishing with the "white polishing abrasive disc" in conjunction with the "cream cleaner".
- Always finish by buffing using the "cream cleaner" and the "yellow micro fibre cloth".
- · Finally polish the product to restore it to its original lustre (Refer to section entitled "every day cleaning")

Other Spillages

- Accidental spills of strong chemicals, (e.g. hair dye, paint stripper, brush cleaners, metal cleaners, cleaners containing methylene chloride, acid drain cleaners, acetone based nail varnish removers etc.), should be washed away immediately using plenty of soapy water to avoid damaging the surface.
- For nail varnish spills, non-acetone based remover can be used and then flushed with water.
